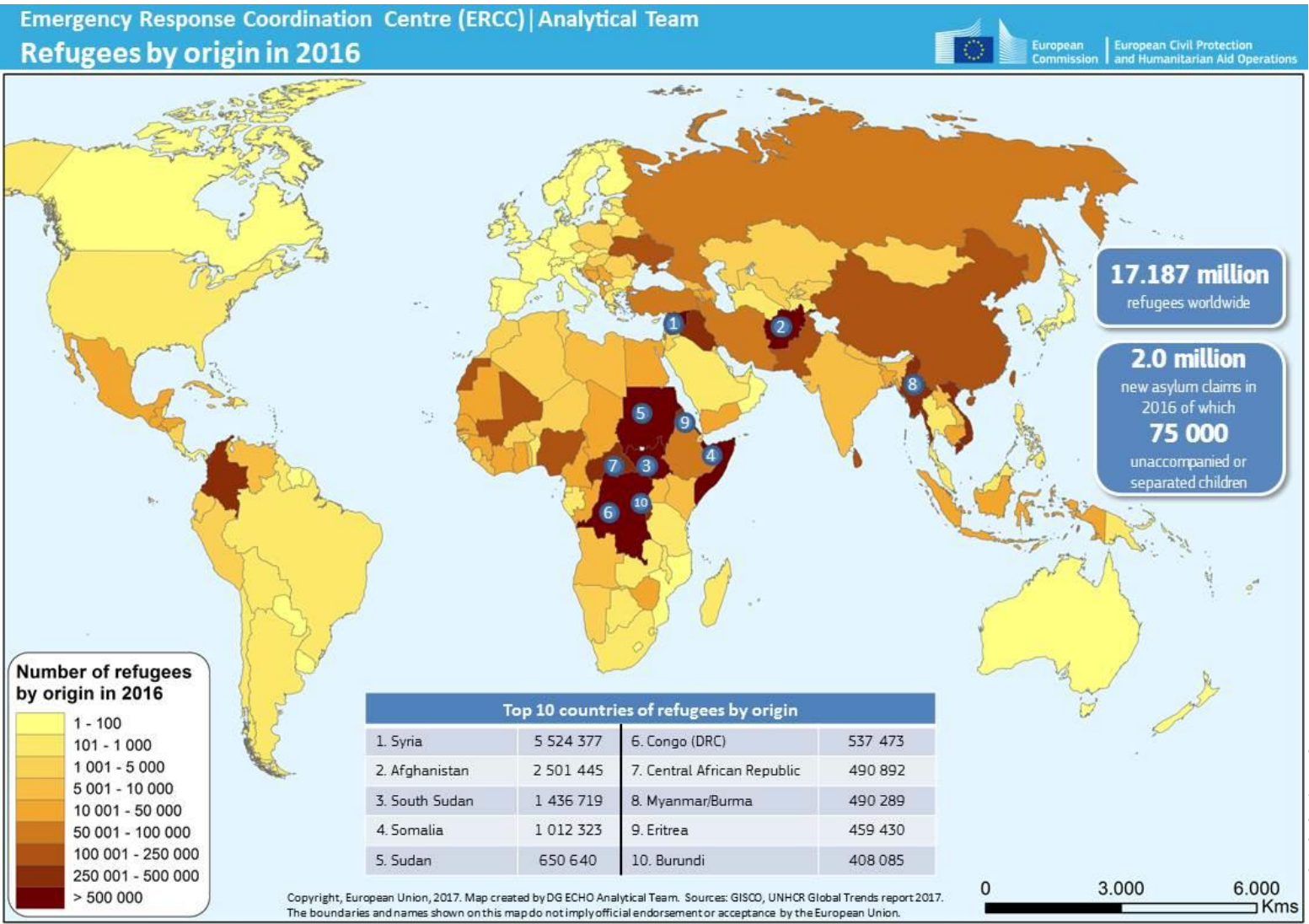

Why?

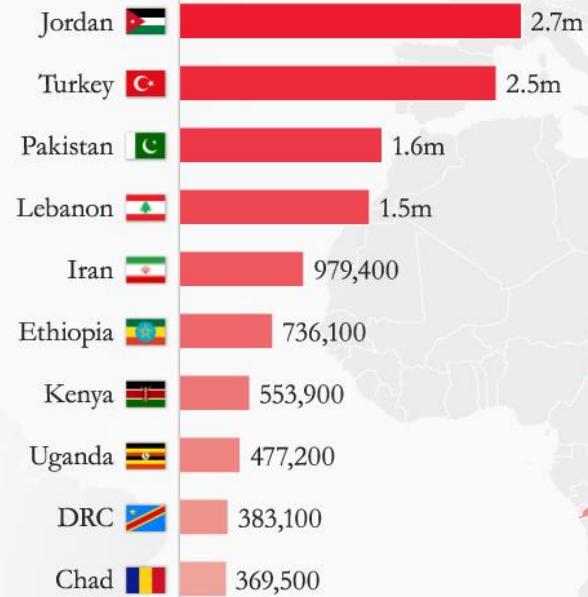
- Well-founded fear of persecution

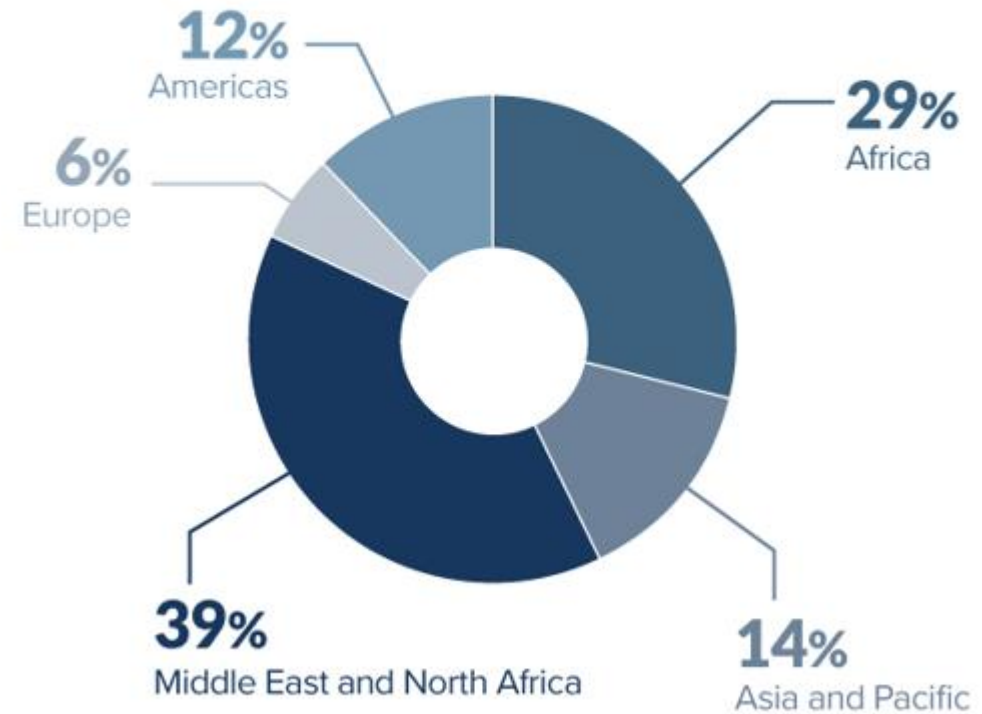

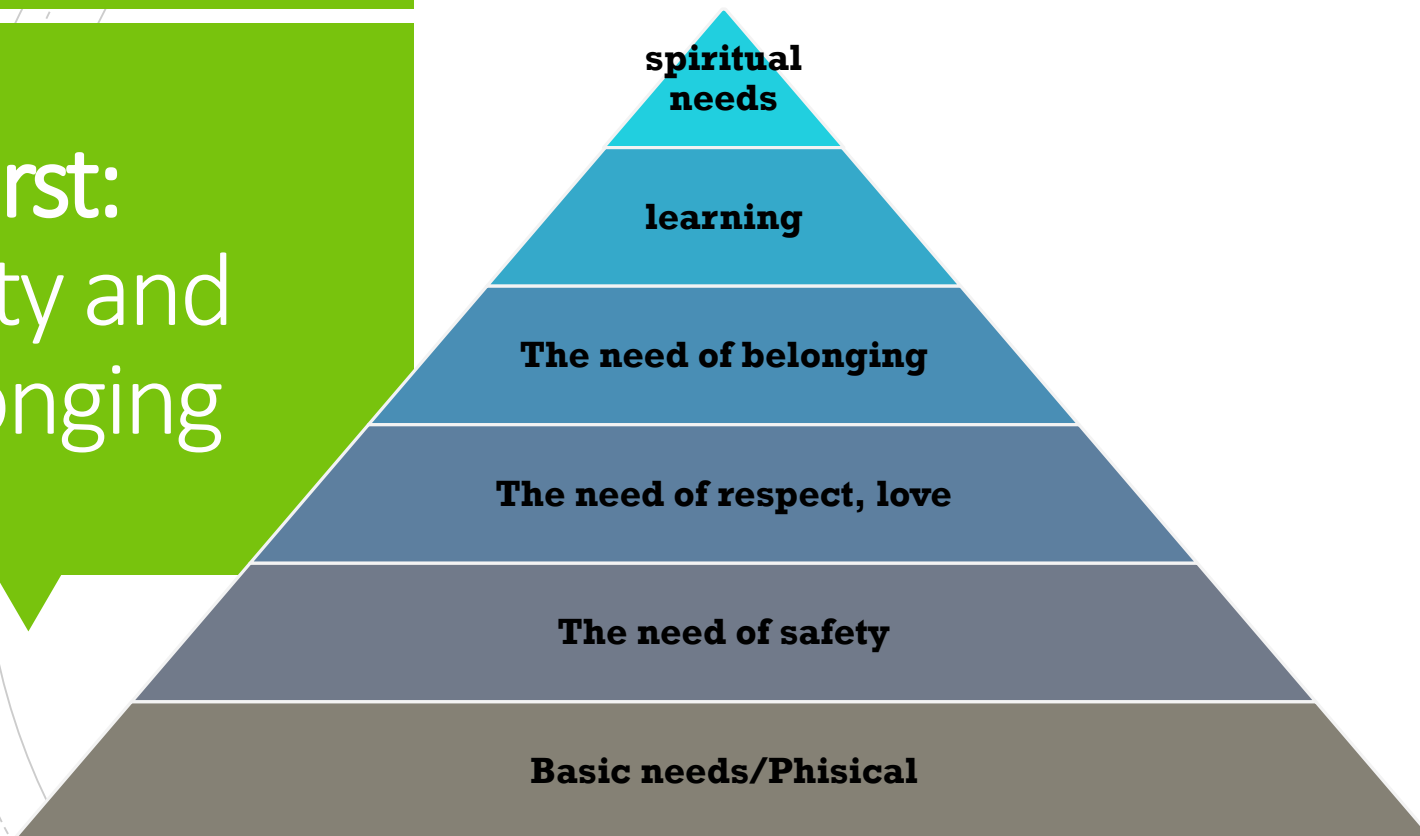

## Refugees – emotional context

- Very limited stabilization
- Limited support with family
- Feeling of danger (lack of status, danger for family)
- Loss
- Trauma – PTSD, generated in country of origin and during the way
- Limited trust
- In children: development disorders which are a result of above

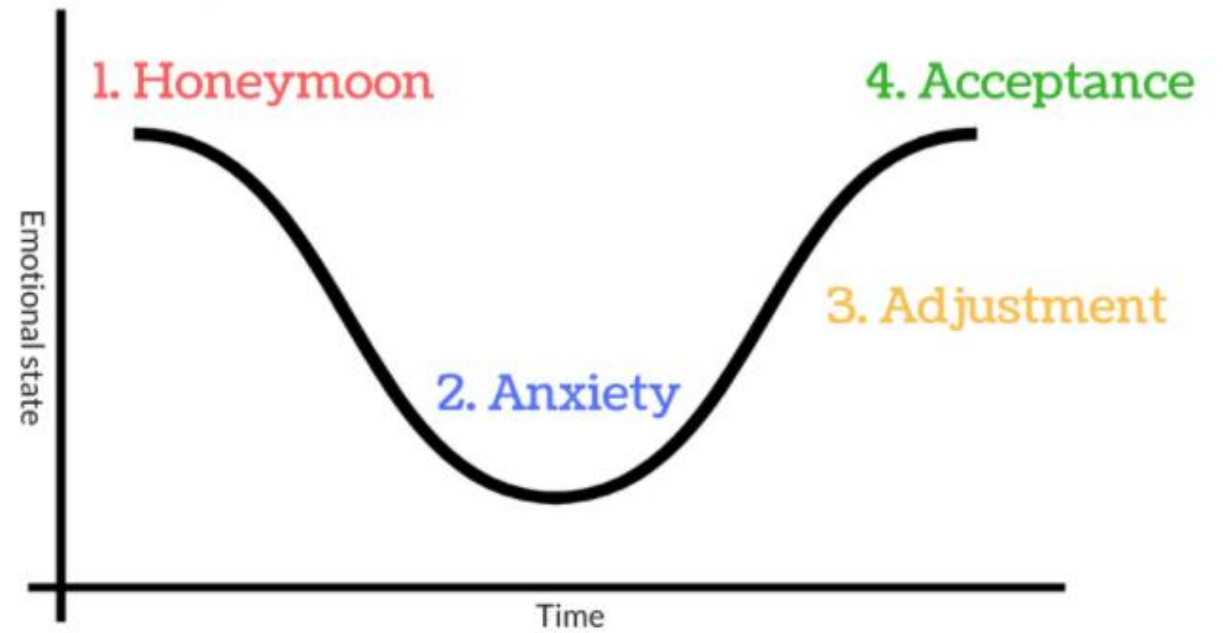
